
On December 3rd, UCloud reached 5000 users! There has been an impressive growth of users on the platform this fall: 1000 new users since the end of August. Moving into the third year with the National HPC services, it is evident that UCloud has diversified the use of HPC across different fields of research by lowering the threshold for non-experts, has proven extremely useful for teaching and is now increasingly used by all universities in Denmark.

Other news include that the LUMI (Large Unified Modern Infrastructure) supercomputer was recognized in the annual HPCwire Readers' and Editors' Choice Awards, announced at the International Conference for High Performance Computing, Networking, Storage, and Analysis (SC22), in Dallas, Texas. LUMI was recognized with the Editors' Choice: Best Sustainability Innovation in HPC. Also at SC22, LUMI maintained its position as one of the fastest and greenest supercomputers in the world on the Top500 list.


