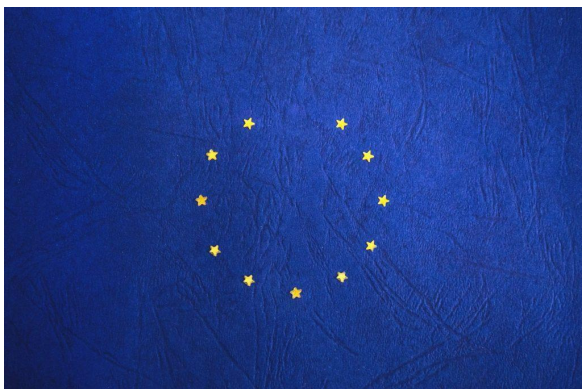
Read about an important milestone that was reached in September: 2000 users on UCloud! It has only been a year since the DeiC Interactive HPC facility (which is based on UCloud) started, and the steady increase in users since then clearly indicates the demand for this type of facility in Denmark.

We also had the pleasure of talking to the representative from the Faculty of Business and Social Sciences in the eScience Operational Board, Prof. WSR Oliver Baumann. 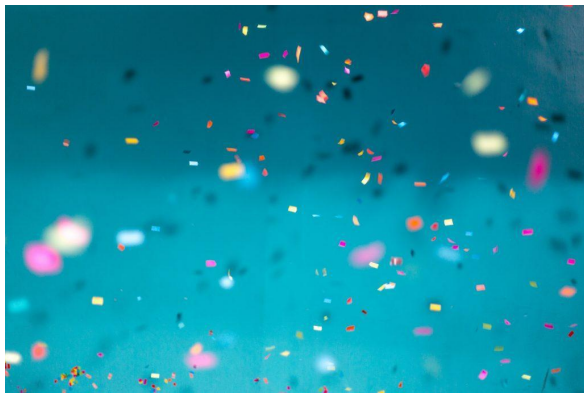
